NATIONAL CHRISTIAN HERITAGE SUNDAY
TO GIVE THANKS FOR THE CHRISTIAN GOSPEL
COMING FOR THE FIRST TIME TO AUSTRALIAN SOIL**

Churches across the country today are celebrating the anniversary of the first known Christian Service held in Australia, which was conducted by the Reverend Richard Johnson on the 3 February 1788, the first Sunday after the First Fleet arrived on 26 January 1788.

His proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ was based on

Psalm 116:12

“What shall I render unto the Lord for all His benefits toward me?”

(AUSTRALIA – A COUNTRY RICHLY BLESSED)

Australia has been richly blessed by the goodness and mercy of God. There is so much as a nation, that we need to give thanks to our Heavenly Father as we reflect, on our parliamentary democracy, freedom of speech, freedom of religion and worship, our legal system and the independence of our courts of law.

Today, on this anniversary may we pause and recognise the Lord’s benefits to this nation and give him thanks for our Christian heritage that has made Australia the great nation it is today.

(PRESERVING OUR NATION’S FUTURE)

As we look to the future may we seek together to preserve our Christian heritage. May we continue to love and serve the Lord Jesus Christ for the good of all and the honour of his name, in the sure knowledge that:

“At the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father” (Philippians 2:10-11)
